

Stretching PECTORALS and anterior capsule

Gently turn your body away from the arm Do not raise the arm so high if any pain – start lower and work your way up- hold stretch for a nice slow 20 secs.



TRICEPS – see how far your fingers can reach down your spine.Gently assist with other hand
